The Association was later expanded to include college/university teacher preparation faculty, affirming a need to recruit and staff schools with excellent teachers.

All applicants must be graduating seniors student teaching at a SAEE member college during the current academic year.

Application Criteria:

The applicant must:

1. Submit a completed application form with all attachments
2. Demonstrate a passion for teaching recognized by the college education department and the Student Teaching Scholarship Selection Committee of SAEE
3. Demonstrate financial need
4. Be recognized by others for his/her commitment to a career in education
